What Will Stay the Same for Sonographer Registrants

ARDMS will continue to be your certification organization.

The ARDMS website (www.ARDMS.org) and phone numbers (800-541-9754 and 301-738-8401) will stay the same.

MY ARDMS (www.ARDMS.org/MYARDMS) will continue as your personal portal for information on your certifications, applications and payments.

The sonographer RDMS, RDCS, RVT and RMSKS credentials will continue to be awarded by and governed by a volunteer-led team of your peers.

The application process and current prerequisite requirements will continue to be available via www.ARDMS.org.

Your Maintenance of Certification program, which includes the annual renewal fee and CME Audit program, will remain the same.

ARDMS will continue to accept the same CME sponsors.

What Will Change

ARDMS will return to its roots and serve solely the needs of Sonographers.

ARDMS will get a new look and logo in June 2016. You will begin seeing this change on the website, ID cards, certificates, etc.

The physician RPIV and RMSK credentials will transition to the new APCA organization in June 2016.*
